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# OUR CORE VALUES

## TORAH: LIFELONG LEARNING

**TORAH is stimulating study for people of all ages that transforms the way we see and live in the world.**

The **Miriam & Moses Center for Pluralistic Adult Jewish Learning** offers a robust selection of adult education opportunities throughout the year. In addition to our weekly Shabbat Torah Study, special offerings this year include:

- **Scholar-in-Residence Shabbatot**—Four times this year (September, November, March, and June), we will host prominent Jewish scholars for Shabbat study. Experts in their fields, our scholars-in-residence will explore topics such as Judaism and addiction, the legacy of Rabbi Jacob Rudin, the Reform movement's new Torah commentary, American Jewish history, and LGBTQ+ Jewish life.
- **Tuesday Symposium**—Rabbi Stoller will teach two semester-long courses of 13 sessions each, giving learners the opportunity to engage deeply with the subject matter. The fall course (September to December) will explore The History of Antisemitism, while the spring course (January to May) will examine The Thought and Works of Maimonides.
- **Let's Talk About Israel**—We will host a variety of guest speakers for ongoing conversations about current events, history, and culture in modern Israel.
- **Rabbi Stoller at North Shore Towers**—Rabbi Stoller will host a monthly Coffee & Conversation at North Shore Towers, inviting our members who live there and other interested residents to come together for discussions of current events and other timely Jewish topics.
- **Music and Torah**—Rabbi Megan Brumer will teach a course on How to Chant Torah (Part 1: October to December; Part 2: March) and Cantorial Soloist Stephanie Horowitz-Mulry will lead The Music and Legacy of Debbie Friedman (January to February).
- **Aging in Place**—In this three-part series, local experts on aging will offer guidance and resources on how to prepare our families and our homes for navigating the aging process with grace, safety, and dignity.

**The Kehillah Project**, our youth education program, creates a warm, friendly, inclusive, and joyful environment where our children learn, make friends, and grow. In addition to creative and flexible classroom experiences, students and their families will take field trips, participate in social action and community service, and experience Jewish values in action.

## AVODAH: WORSHIP & SPIRITUALITY

**AVODAH is traditional and modern prayer, enhanced by the joy of music, that meets the diverse spiritual needs of 21st-century Jews.**

Temple Beth-El has an active worship and spiritual life. Our outstanding clergy team—Rabbi Brian Stoller, Rabbi Megan Brumer, Cantorial Soloist Stephanie Horowitz-Mulry, Music Director Shy Kedmi, and Choir Director Dr. Pam Levy—create prayer experiences that balance tradition and creativity, inspire joy and reflection, and cause our spirits to soar. Every TBE service is soulful and musical, and includes a thought-provoking sermon. We read Torah on the last Friday night of every month. In addition, our services frequently include guest speakers and other special celebrations.

Music is central to the spiritual life of Temple Beth-El. In addition to Stephanie's majestic voice and Shy's soul-stirring piano playing, our house band, Stephanie & the Shabbatones—which joins our clergy on the bimah bimonthly—adds texture and richness to our Friday night worship. Rabbi Stoller and Rabbi Megan join in, too, on the mandolin and the guitar. Our adult choir enriches our prayer experience on the High Holidays, at our annual Martin Luther King Jr. Interfaith Service, and at other times throughout the year.

Shabbat and holidays are opportunities to both pray and connect with fellow congregants. Weekly Shabbat morning services are followed by a community kiddush brunch. Our Daily Virtual Morning Minyan, which meets on Zoom every Monday to Friday, is a warm and welcoming community of people not only from Temple Beth-El, but also from Reform communities around the East Coast and Midwest.

## G'MILUT CHASADIM: CARING & SOCIAL ACTION

**G'MILUT CHASADIM are acts of kindness that touch our congregants' lives and make our wider community a better place.**

Social action has long been at the heart of Temple Beth-El's mission and identity. As Reform Jews, we are committed to doing our part to make our community and our world better places for everyone to live. Our efforts include writing letters encouraging citizens to exercise their right to vote, feeding the hungry in our local community, and building strong interfaith relationships. As the first synagogue on Long Island to "go green," we work to keep our environment clean. The Kehillah Project children and their families spend time during the year cleaning up local parks. Our annual winter Tzedakah Project provides holiday meals to hundreds of families in Great Neck. TBE volunteers visit hospital patients during the holidays to sing and bring cheer. Our award-winning Brotherhood helps run the Interfaith Food Pantry at St. Aloysius Roman Catholic Church. In all these ways and more, we serve our community and God by the works of our hands.

Just as we are committed to helping the wider community, we are deeply involved in tending to the well-being of our congregational family. In partnership with our rabbis, our Chesed (Caring) Committee helps mark the joyful moments in our lives, comfort the bereaved in meaningful ways, and provide support to all members of our community during times of need. Our volunteers make outreach calls to people who have lost a loved one, invite congregants to temple gatherings, and check in on homebound individuals. Through our medical lending program, durable medical supplies are accessible to congregants and community members who are in need of equipment.

In addition, we care for our community by spreading joy on the Jewish holidays. At Rosh Hashanah, we pack and deliver honey and challah to our older congregants; and at Purim, our volunteers bring hamantaschen and sweetness to their homes.

## KEHILLAH: COMMUNITY

**KEHILLAH is about social and cultural activities that build community and give our members a sense of belonging.**

Temple Beth-El has a vibrant communal and social life, packed with cultural programs, field trips to New York City, congregational Shabbat dinners, and fun social events. Among the highlights are:

- **Susan Stumer Jewish Cultural Arts**—Our thriving partnership with the Gold Coast Arts Center has established TBE as a center for Jewish cultural arts on the Great Neck peninsula. This year, we will host regularly scheduled cultural arts programs at our temple, including concerts by national and local musicians, book talks with important authors, a tour of TBE's renowned Jewish art collection, a performance of an acclaimed off-Broadway musical, film screenings, and food tastings.
- **TBE Explorers**—This group of adults takes monthly field trips to experience the amazing cultural life of New York City and Long Island.
- **Comedy Nights**—Our late-January annual Comedy Night, featuring a slate of hilarious comedians, is a cure for the wintertime blues. As a new addition, we kicked off our program year in August with Rosh HaHaHa, a fantastic night of comedy, cocktails, and community in our rooftop Rudin Garden.
- **Brotherhood and Men's Groups**—Our award-winning Brotherhood provides opportunities for the men of our congregation to serve the synagogue and our wider community, including its work supporting the Great Neck Interfaith Food Pantry at St. Aloysius Church. Holy Spirits, our men's dinner and discussion group, brings men of all ages together for fellowship and conversation with Rabbi Stoller throughout the year.
- **Sisterhood and Women's Groups**—By volunteering together and enjoying Girls' Night Out dinners, book discussions, and social activities, Sisterhood members build bonds of connection with each other and the synagogue. This year, the women of TBE will also get together for fun experiences including a recipe swap and a mosaic art workshop.

## ISRAEL: THE LAND OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE

**ISRAEL is about recognizing the special relationship among Jews throughout the world, along with the unique and essential bond we share with the State of Israel.**

Temple Beth-El is deeply committed to learning about, experiencing, and supporting the people and the State of Israel. Among the key opportunities to get involved with Israel this year are:

- **Congregational Israel Trip (March 4 to 12)**—Organized by TBE's Israel Committee and Rabbi Stoller, our trip will be an incredible opportunity to experience and learn about post-October 7 Israel. In addition to the must-see historical sites of our Holy Land in Jerusalem and Tel Aviv, the group will also visit the Nova Music Festival site and the Gaza Envelope, and meet with Israelis whose lives were forever changed by the events of that day.
- **Beginning Adult Conversational Hebrew**—Congregants Joanne Davis and Danna Sobiecki will teach a no-pressure, fun six-session class designed for beginners. Participants will learn useful phrases, practice speaking in a relaxed setting, and gain confidence with the basics. No previous knowledge is required.
- **Let's Talk About Israel**—We will host a variety of guest speakers for ongoing conversation about current events, history, and culture in modern Israel.
- **Community October 7 Commemoration**—On Sunday, October 5, we will host a Great Neck commemoration of October 7 in partnership with the Gold Coast Arts Center. The service will feature Israeli music performed by an ensemble of local musicians and Shireinu Choir of Long Island.
- **Author Yaakov Katz**—In another incredible opportunity made possible through our partnership with the Gold Coast Arts Center, the Israeli author will speak about his new book, *While Israel Slept: How Hamas Surprised the Most Powerful Military in the Middle East*, at TBE on Wednesday, October 22.

### ISRAEL COMMITTEE

This committee is dedicated to supporting Israel by fostering a deep and enduring commitment to Zionism, striving to strengthen connections with the Jewish state through education, advocacy, and engagement by

providing resources and opportunities to explore the country's rich culture, history, and current events.

### MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

Along with our engagement and programming director, this team integrates new members into the Temple Beth-El community, spreads the word about our wonderful congregation, and helps attract new members to the temple.

### SUSAN STUMER CULTURAL ARTS COMMITTEE

To create cultural arts programs for our congregation and the broader Great Neck community, this group partners with TBE's engagement and

programming director as well as the Gold Coast Arts Center.

### **TBE EXPLORERS PLANNING TEAM**

This planning group arranges cultural, learning, and other community outings for our community.

### **WORSHIP COMMITTEE**

Partnering with our clergy, this committee imagines and engages congregants in the prayer life of our community.

### **YOUTH PARENT TASK FORCE**

This task force partners with Rabbi Megan to support and strengthen youth and family engagement at Temple Beth-El. During a few Sunday morning meetings a year, parents can offer input on aspects of our religious school and help shape engaging and meaningful programs and experiences for our youth community.

### **SPOUSAL BEREAVEMENT GROUP**

Facilitated by licensed social worker Michelle Gibson, the social services supervisor at the Sid Jacobson JCC, this group offers our members who have recently lost a spouse an opportunity to find comfort, support, and understanding with others who are also navigating this very difficult time. A phone intake is required prior to joining the group.

### **SUPPORTING INTERFAITH FAMILIES: A GRANDPARENTS GROUP**

Facilitated by licensed social worker Michelle Gibson, the social services supervisor at the Sid Jacobson JCC, this group is for grandparents navigating interfaith dynamics within their families, including relationships with grandchildren, adult children, and extended family. A phone intake is required prior to joining the group.
